DOCUMENTATION DETAILS

PROJECT APPLICATION & AGREEMENT: All projects require the submission of an ACC PROJECT APPLICATION & AGREEMENT
SITE PLAN: If indicated above, include a detailed site plan with the locations of the house, driveway, culverts, patios, all sidewalks, and septic field clearly shown
New home construction site plans should be based on a professional survey. Smaller projects can suffice with simpler hand drawn plans. Take special note if your project is close to a lot boundary.
If there's a chance that fences or outbuildings will be constructed with a new home construction project, it is suggested they be shown on the site plan to eliminate the need for another ACC submittal (and corresponding fees therein).
HOUSE PLANS : If indicated above, please include house plans with a detailed floor plan with clearly defined square footage of living space, garages, patios and sidewalks. Roof plan indicating roof slope and materials is required.
Section detail plans, cabinet plans, door/window schedules, etc. are NOT required for the project application.
EXTERIOR ELEVATIONS : If indicated above, include full exterior façade elevation (all sides). All homes should have a minimum of 33% brick or stone veneer on the outside of the house (preferably 50%+) and be designed in similar look / aesthetic appeal to other homes in the neighborhood. Brick, stone, and exterior paint colors should be provided during the application process.
GEOTECHNICAL REPORT: Due to the volatile nature of the clay soils in this area, all new home construction and home expansion projects require a formal Geotechnical Report (if not previously done) to be factored into the professionally engineered foundation plan.
FOUNDATION PLAN: If indicated above, provide a professionally engineered foundation plan stamped by a licensed professional engineer.

It is understood that some changes will occur during the construction process. However, significant variances may result in additional ACC Fees being assessed, up to 100% of the original fee. Please notify the ACC of any changes that occur during construction that differ from any submittal item noted above.

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
