FAQ

1. Why do we need governance in Digital Motorsports for Singapore?

The growing interest and the fast-developing community in digital motorsports call for a dedicated body and structured governance to develop this sport. So that the entire community can develop professionally and grow systematically in this discipline, building depth of skills, nurturing talents and integrate various organisations and relevant entities towards a common goal. As the role of MSS is to administer and govern motor sports in Singapore, digital motorsports has been included by virtue of the same genre, only now in digital format.

2. Who should come under this governance?

It is non-obligatory for digital motorsports players or organisers who engage in casual participation to be accounted for, although it is highly encouraged. However, should a player or anyone who plans to develop their skills seriously and professionally, MSS together with Delta Timers will guide and develop individuals towards better skills via a suite of MSS-Delta Timers-led programmes and initiatives. Together with development of technical knowledge, alignment with FIA sanctioned rules and guidelines, the digital motorsports community can then develop the sport professionally.

3. Who is Delta Timers?

Delta Timers Pte Ltd is officially appointed by Motor Sports Singapore (MSS) to co-develop the ecosystem of digital motorsports and associated motorsports activities in Singapore. Made up of a team of professionals from diverse industry backgrounds committed to see digital motorsport industry accelerate further. Working with all interested individuals, likeminded commercial partners and organisations in an unbiased manner to expand the interest, grow the community and develop the sport with MSS.

4. What is the role of an 'Aggregator'?

As an 'aggregator' of digital motorsports, Delta Timers is set up with the vision to integrate various entities of the sport such as players, organisers, sponsors, organisations and the wider public in a non-discriminatory manner in view of the greater good and overall digital motorsports development.

5. How will MSS & Delta Timers engage the Digital Motorsports community?

- 1. Create a strong digital motorsports presence in Singapore by collaborating with race organisers, promoters, training programmes for officials and players, and activate engagement for the larger community.
- 2. Collaborate with industry partners for opportunities in digital motorsports talents to race, feature professionally, and represent Singapore in regional and global competitions.
- 3. Build a strong digital motorsports ecosystem with MSS partners, media and members in partnering with the government and non-government organisations, commercial entities and individuals in an integrated manner.
- 4. Chart the growth journey for digital motorsports development in Singapore through mid and long-term plans.
- 5. Extend digital motorsports engagement beyond the confines of digital platforms and leisure/professional activities to objectives such as motoring education, community engagement and related innovation.

6. What are the plans going into 2022?

- 1. 1st Quarter Collaborate and co-facilitate races with at least 2 event partners in short period races lasting 1 day to 12 weeks at AAS premises and partner venues.
- 2. 2nd Quarter Outreach program held at various partner venues.
- 3. 3rd Quarter A nation wide MSS-Delta Timers race event to identify all finalists from the various race events held in first and second quarters to seed and rank them so that they can be aligned for qualification and competition in the inaugural 4th Quarter event.
- 4. 4th Quarter An FIA sanctioned event in Singapore.
