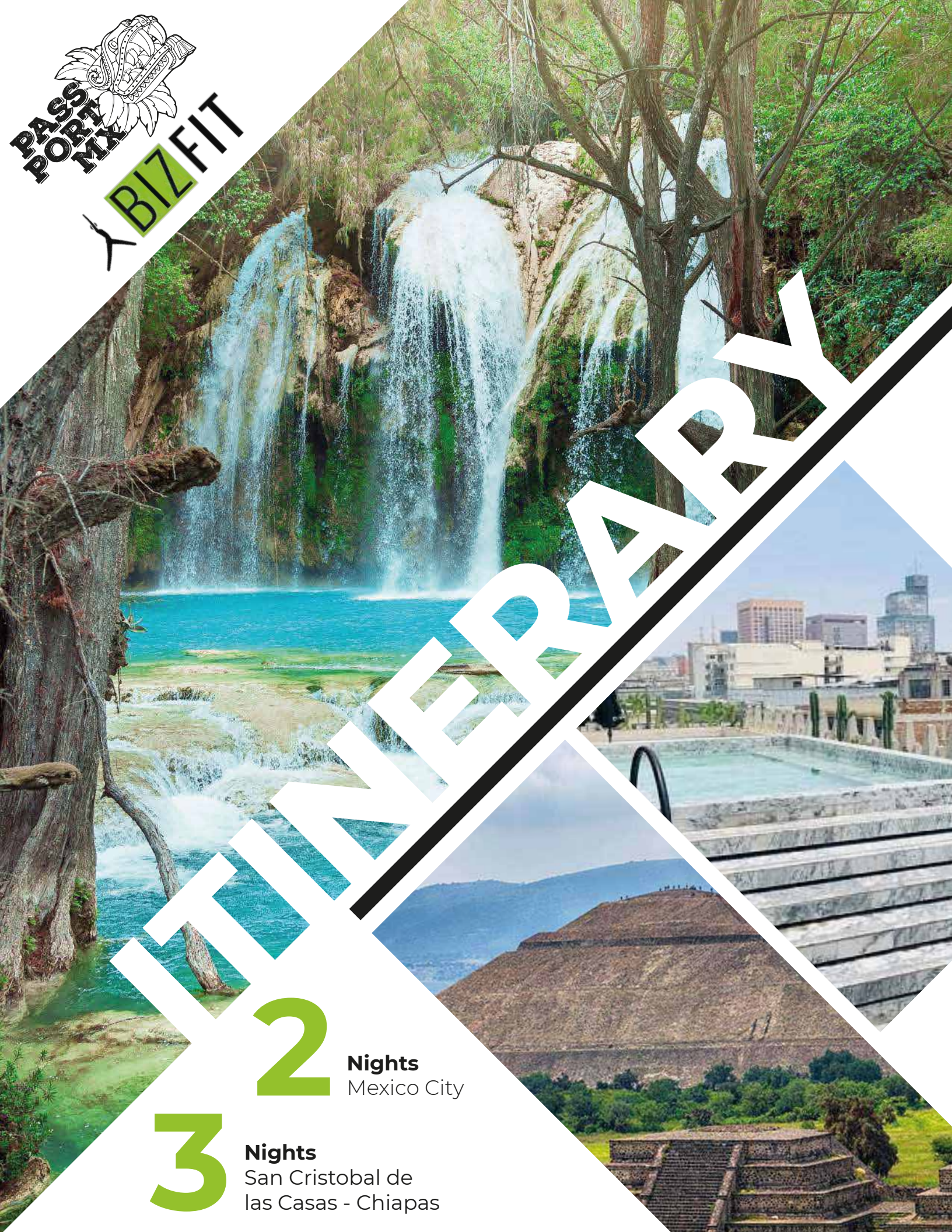

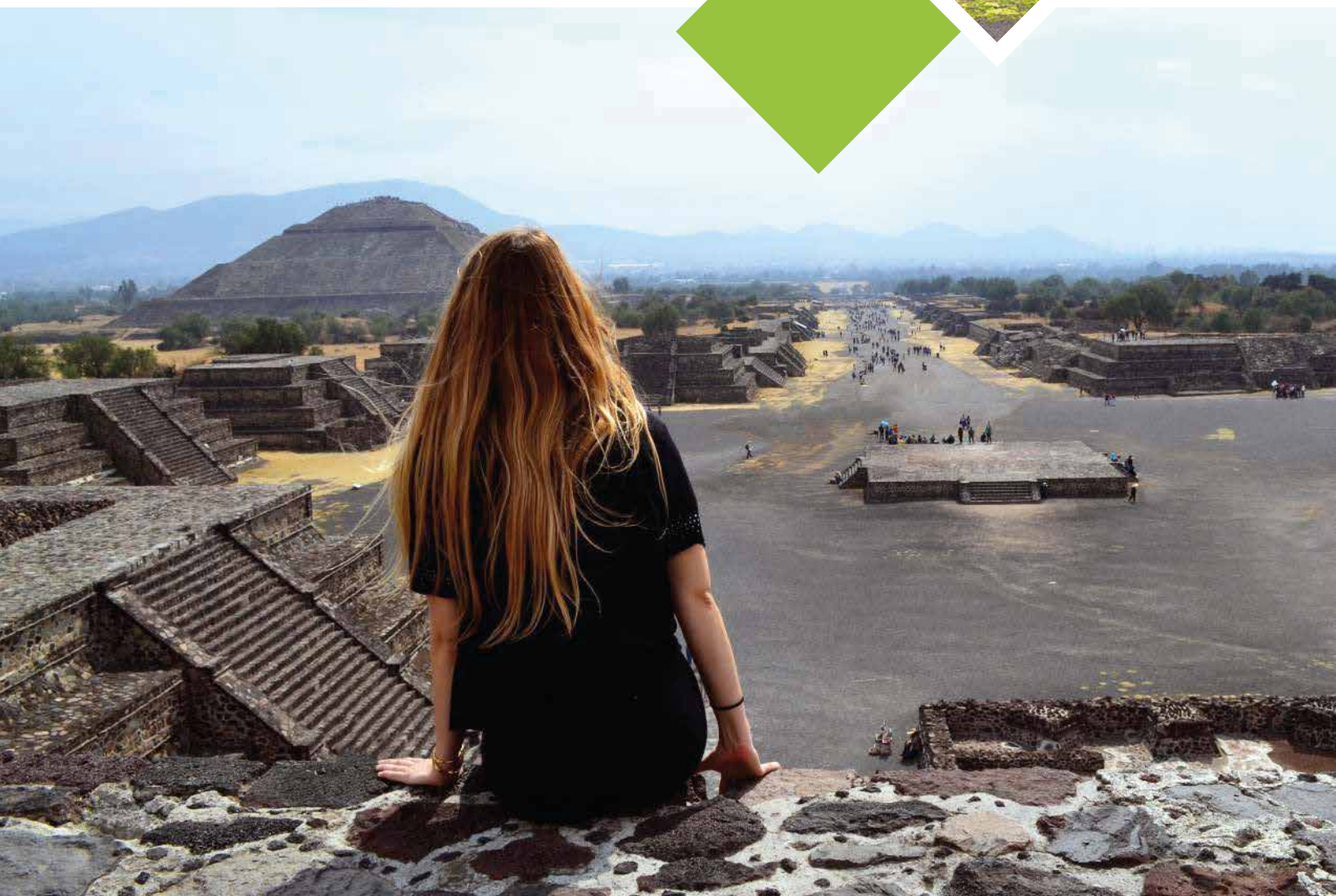

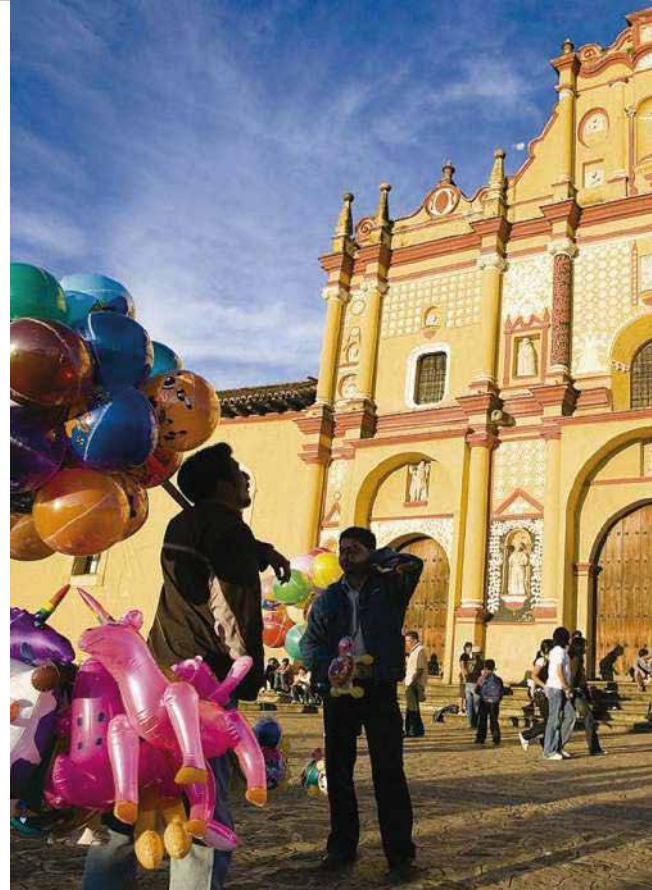

Confirmation, Changes and Cancellations

Upon receipt of deposit, you will receive a reservation confirmation from us. This will confirm your itinerary as presented. Additional activities you'd like can also be requested at this time until 30 days from departure. After which time, we'll make every effort to accommodate modifications, but any change fees or charges will be the responsibility of the client.

The airline allows for one free name change on the reservation. Additional name changes are at a fee determined by the airline. Client pays all airline fees associated with modifications or alterations initiated by the client or traveler. If you need to change the name on your ticket, please contact us and we will initiate the process. No part of the airfare is refundable. This is airline policy. Travel credits valid for 1 year from the date of cancellation, and made in the name of the passenger will be issued 30 days prior to departure for cancellations. 30 days prior to departure, no cancellations, no changes, no refunds, no travel credits.

If for any reason you'd like to change the dates of the trip, we will do our best to accommodate your request. We will research costs and provide you with an invoice for the difference in cost. Note that there is a small chance that availability on some items quoted may change. If this is the case, we will present similar accommodations or activities for your consideration.

Insurance

It is your responsibility to arrange all insurance for yourself, your baggage, and personal liability. While we do not anticipate any issues, it is strongly recommended that you purchase emergency evacuation and medical insurance. A list of insurance companies can be provided upon request. By paying the amount due, you acknowledge that you understand and assume all risks if you decide not to purchase insurance.

Money Exchange & Credit Cards

While many places in Mexico City take credit cards, many smaller vendors do not accept credit cards. It's always best to have cash on hand, just in case. Mexico can be quite inexpensive. Depending on your spending habits, you may want to bring at least \$500 USD with you to cover basic costs of food for your stay. Some ATM's in Mexico have agreements with USA banks to waive ATM fees. Check with your bank at least 60 days prior to departure to inquire about ATM fees, foreign exchange fees, and other bank policies.

Most banks in the USA will offer currency conversion to Mexican Pesos if you give them enough time to prepare. There are also many currency exchange options in the country that will exchange dollars for pesos with fairly competitive exchange rates.
