Day 7 - From Outrage to Intercession

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.1 Peter 2:9

Devotion

You are not just a person with opinions—you are a royal priesthood. That means your role isn't to echo the culture's outrage but to stand between God and man in intercession.
