Day 5 – Honor Isn't Convenient—It's Commanded

**Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves.
Romans 12:10**

Devotion

Honor isn't a reward for good behavior. It's a lifestyle rooted in how you see people. To honor someone means to treat them with dignity, even when they don't 'deserve' it. Why? Because they bear God's image, even when they act like a fool.

If honor only shows up when it's easy, it's not honor—it's preference. True honor is forged in the furnace of conflict and revealed when it's least convenient.
