MAIN SCRIPTURES

- Exodus 20:1–2 The Ten Words establish God's covenant boundaries.
- **Joshua 5:13–15** "Neither, but as Commander of the army of the LORD I have now come."
- **Deuteronomy 19:14** "Do not remove your neighbor's landmark..."
- Micah 2:1-2 "They devise iniquity... so they oppress a man and his inheritance."
- Leviticus 19:15 "In righteousness you shall judge your neighbor."

KEY POINTS

1. God Sets the Lines

 From Sinai to the Promised Land, boundaries are covenant markers of inheritance, protection, and order.

2. God Is Not Partisan

 The Commander of the LORD's Army didn't take sides — He came to enforce God's side.

3. Moving Stones Is Injustice

 Whether in land or legislation, shifting boundaries for advantage distorts God's order.

4. Babylon's Playbook

Babylon changes boundaries — moral, family, civic — to gain control.

5. The Church's Call



 Be Repairers of the Breach (Isaiah 58:12) — restore God's boundaries in personal life and public life.

- Engage Protect truth and fairness in your community.
