

Rodeo basics

The basic seven events at PRCA ProRodeos are in three categories:

Timed Events

Steer wrestling, team roping and tiedown roping require highly trained horses who work with their riders to catch and control cattle.

Roughstock Events

Bareback riding, saddle bronc riding and bull riding match a cowboy's skill in staying aboard for eight seconds against a bucking horse's or bull's determination to remove him.

Barrel racing

Horse and rider complete a cloverleaf pattern around three barrels; fastest time wins.



Why is success in rodeo measured by money?

Many ProRodeo contestants compete in dozens of rodeos across the country each year. Arenas vary greatly in size, which particularly affects results in the timed events. Each rodeo can use one or more of the PRCA's 80-plus stock contractors, many of whom own hundreds of bucking horses and bulls, whose average scores may vary. The only consistent measurement across all these variables is the amount of money earned.

Your first rodeo?

You're at the most exciting, most spontaneous, and most uniquely American sports event you've ever experienced! It's truly different from all other professional sports:

Western heritage: Most rodeo events are tied directly to skills that cowboys used to manage cattle on the vast open ranges of the frontier, and many of those skills are still used today.

Animal athletics: All rodeo events involve the participation of animals some highly trained, others operating on instinct. Owners take great care of their animals to ensure peak performance.

Pay to play: Contestants pay entry fees in order to participate. If they place high, they'll probably show a profit for the day. And if not, well, we hope you clap for their efforts anyway, because every contestant is doing his or her best.

Cooperative competitors: Cowboys frequently advise each other on how to ride particular horses or bulls, loan each other horses and equipment, and share travel expenses even with their closest rivals!

No wealthy team owners: Most rodeo committees are staffed entirely or almost entirely by volunteers who put in scads of hours producing the rodeo.

Know your rodeo lingo

Barrier: a line at the end of the box that the contestant and his horse cannot cross until the calf or steer has a head start

Box: in a timed event, the area a horse and rider back into before making a run

Bulldogger: a steer wrestler

Bullfighter: an athlete who protects the bull rider after he dismounts or is bucked off by distracting the bull and directing its attention to the exit gate, sometimes stepping between the bull and the bull rider

Calf roper: a tie-down roper

Chute: the pen that holds and animal safely in position; the timed-events chutes are usually across the arena from the roughstock chutes Covering: staying on for at least eight seconds Draw: each roughstock competitor who enters a PRCA rodeo is assigned a specific bucking horse or bull in a random draw conducted at PRCA headquarters three days before the rodeo; each timed-event contestant is assigned a calf or steer in a random draw on site, shortly before each performance of a rodeo begins

Flank strap: in the roughstock events, a sheepskin or Neoprene-lined strap placed in the area where a human's belt would go, which encourages the animal to kick out behind its body rather than "hopping" vertically, providing a showier, safer ride

Hooey: the knotthat a cowboy useses to finish tying the calf's legs together in tie-down roping **Judges:** trained professionals who check the livestock and arena before the rodeo, score riding events, flag timed events, and determine whether all rules were followed by the contestants

Left (or right) delivery: each bucking horse or bull is placed in a chute whose exit gate faces the direction it prefers to use

Mark out: a cowboy's feet must be above a bucking horse's shoulders when the horse makes its first move out of the chute, if so the cowboy "marked out," but if not, he "missed out" and the ride is disqualified

Pickup men: two mounted cowboys who help riders dismount, release the bucking horse's soft flank strap, and escort bucking horses and bulls to the exit gate after a ride

Rank: an adjective of praise and respect used to describe especially challenging roughstock
Roughstock: animals who possess the instinct and desire to buck off their riders

Stock contractors: ranching professionals who bring livestock to the arena bucking horses and bulls, plus steers and calves for timed events

Timed Event: events in which the contestant(s)

who make the fastest qualified runs win.

Powder River Rodeo and D & H Cattle

The Red Desert Roundup Rodeo is proud to have the best livestock in the world from Powder River Rodeo and D & H Cattle. Powder River Rodeo and D & H Cattle were nominated as one of the top 5 PRCA Stock Contractors in 2018. This marks the 8th time that Powder River Rodeo and D & H Cattle were selected as one of the best out of 80 PRCA stock contractors in the United States and Canada.

Powder River Rodeo is entering their 34th year of producing and supplying livestock to Top PRCA rodeos. Powder River Rodeo is owned and operated by Hank and Lori Franzen from Riverton, Wyoming. Since they began supplying livestock to PRCA rodeos, the Franzen's have become known for their world-class bucking horses. Some of these incredible horses include Khadafy Skoal, 3-time Bareback Horse of the year and 2012 Pro Rodeo Hall of Fame Inductee; Miss Congeniality, 2-time Saddle Bronc Horse of the Year; and Craig At Midnight, the 2016 Bareback Horse of the Year.

Craig At Midnight, was voted the Reserve World Champion Bareback Horse for 2017, and also tied for the Top Bareback Horse of the National Finals Rodeo. At the 2018 National Finals Rodeo, Tim O'Connell conquered Craig At Midnight to win Round 3 enroute to his third consecutive world championship. Craig At Midnight has been consistently scored 44 to 48 points over the last 4 years of PRCA rodeo action. He weighs in at 1700 pounds and is one of the biggest bucking horses in the business. Craig was just selected and received the Top Bareback Horse award at the 2019 Red Bluff





D & H Cattle is a bucking bull operation located in Dickson, Oklahoma that is owned and operated by father/son duo, Dillon and H.D. Page. For over 40 years, D & H Cattle has been breeding, training, and bucking some of the best bulls in the world at PBR and PRCA bull riding events. Dillon and H.D. Page still work every day to improve their highly successful breeding program. Some of their incredible bulls include Mossy Oak Mudslinger, 2006 PBR Bucking Bull of the Year; Shepherd Hills Tested, 2013 PRCA Bucking Bull of the Year; Long John, 2015 PBR Bucking Bull of the Year; and the best bull in the PBR and PRCA today, Bruiser.




Cole Melancon wins the 2016 Dinosaur Roundup Rodeo with a 92.5 score on Bruiser. This was the 2016 PRCA regular season high-marked score of the year.

Bruiser won 2016, 2017, and 2018 PBR Bucking Bull of the year, and was also selected as the 2017 PRCA Bucking Bull of the Year to solidify his position as the best bull in the world and one of the greatest of all-time. Bruiser's world champion selection in both the PRCA and PBR in the same year has only happened one other time in the history of these two associations with the legendary "Bodacious" in 1995. Bruiser was also named the Top Bucking Bull of the National Finals Rodeo, a very prestigious award when you are selected by your performance when the stakes are highest!

Powder River Rodeo and D & H Cattle provided the second-highest amount of livestock at the National Finals Rodeo, with 19 of the 300 animals selected to the prestigious championship event. Horses selected were Craig At Midnight, Bob Cat, Black Leg, Knot So Foxy, Cowboy Casino, Miss Chestnut, Double Take, Bombshell, Rich N Fancy, and Show Me Again. Bulls selected were Bruiser, Short Pop, Struttin' Stuff, Heartbreak Kid, Fearless, Jack Shot, Udder Lover, Misfire, and Mind Freak. At the 2018 National Finals Rodeo, five rounds were won on Powder River & D & H athletes...totally awesome performances!!





Craig was a ranch raised colt by Cut The Cards a World Champion Sire and out of mare T33 KC Rocket (Tooke bloodline) he was an absolute fan favorite and a very special animal to everyone who had the pleasure of watching him especially his Powder River family. He will be missed dearly!! He was buried next to World Champion Khadafy under a big cottonwood tree...RIP big boy.

Deryl was born at his family home in Heber City, UT on February 5, 1943 to his loving parents, Otis and Ora Holland Sweat. He is survived by his wife, Kathy Sweat, daughters Amy Sweat (Troy) and Jennifer Sweat Moss (Bryan); his bonus children from his second marriage Brian Kerutis (Cynthia), Michael Kerutis (LeAnn), Tia Blanchard Sweat, Josh Kerutis; Kathy's children Brett Hale (Melody), Bryan Hale (Laura), Cory Hale (Stephanie); his sisters LaRae Jeffs (Hal), Jolyn Hall (Robert), his brother Von Sweat, and many cousins, nieces and nephews, grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Deryl graduated Wasatch High School in 1961 and earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Political Science and History from Utah State University in 1965. He was a member of the Utah Army National Guard where he received the sharp shooter award for his unit. In 1968 he went to work for Ford Motor Company and married DeeAnn (Fox) Sweat in February. They lived in Heber City, and from there moved Great Falls, MT. They then returned to Heber City UT in 1973 where they welcomed their daughters. They relocated to Rock Springs WY in 1977. Deryl married Kathy Unverzagt Hale Sweat August 9, 2008 in Rock Springs, WY. Deryl and Kathy loved dancing together and always said they felt like they had danced together their entire lives. They spent their summers in Eden, WY and winters in Wittman, AZ, enjoying the beauty of both towns and their close-knit communities.
