Three PAA Student Members are Published in May FIAP News

PSA Student members are members of PAA and have the opportunity to have their images published in the Youth Photographer's Gallery of the FIAP News, the quarterly online magazine of the International Federation of Photographic Art (FIAP): fiap.net/en/news. For each issue, countries are limited to no more than three youth photographers being published. Three PAA Student members were published in the May 2026 issue and PAA plans to have USA Student members continue to be published in each issue.

1. Photographer must be **under 25 years of age** as of the closing date for the *FIAP News* edition to which the photos are being submitted.
2. Each photographer should submit **5 photos** (three would be published).
3. Photos need to be **1024 pixels on the longest dimension**, 96ppi, sRGB color space, and saved as the highest quality jpgs.
4. There is **no set subject**. Images can be **color or monochrome**. Strictly **no nude photography**.
5. **All components** of the final photo, and modifications of the final photo, **must be the work of the photographer**, e.g., no clip art, no other person to work on the photo, no photos that have AI created components.
6. Photographers **under the age of 18 must have the consent of their parent or legal guardian** to submit photographs for possible publication in the *FIAP News*.
7. Photographers must send the following with the photographs:
 - a. Photographer's **name**
 - b. Photographer's **date of birth and age**
 - c. A **title for each photo**
 - d. If the photographer is **under 18 years of age**, an **"Author's Agreement Form for Minors,"** signed by a

parent or legal guardian
f. Photographers who are **18 years of age or older** must sign and submit the adult **"Author's Agreement Form"**

The photos, plus the required information and the applicable Author's Agreement form, are to be sent to: **Joanne Stolte, FIAP Liaison Officer for the USA**, jbstolte@aol.com as soon as possible. The first three PSA Youth Members to send their images will be submitted for the next issue of the FIAP News, and so on each quarter.

This is not a competition. There will however be a selection made to best show photographs from youth photographers of different ages and from different countries. Technical image quality will be a consideration, but the concepts and composition will be prioritized as appropriate for the photographer's age. The photographer's name, age, country, and the title of the photo will be published with the selected photos.
