

Feeling Lucky?

Here's the scoop on random drug & alcohol testing in transit operations:



Your employer must include all safety-sensitive employees in the random testing pool.



Using a scientifically valid method (a computer program) employees are randomly selected for testing. Each employee has an equal chance of being selected every time a new list is generated.



It's possible for you to be randomly selected more frequently than others, or not at all, it's just the luck of the draw!



Your employer conducts random testing on varying days of the week and at varying times of the day, to ensure that no predictable pattern of testing is created.



If you're notified that you've been selected, you must proceed immediately to the testing location. A delay in your arrival may be considered a refusal to submit to testing.
