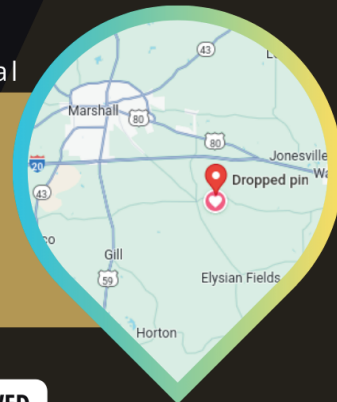

The Community Dumpster Project - Your Complete Guide

In October 2023, Melissa & Heath Kelly of **Done With It Hauling & Removal** saw illegal dumping becoming a real problem in Harrison County and decided to do something about it. Nothing like this existed, so they built it. As a **local junk removal and dumpster rental company**, they were uniquely positioned to make it happen — donating the dumpsters, equipment, time, and labor. A generous local landowner provides the space. Serving neighbors aligns with their faith. This is simply how they give back — and it earned them the **2025 Greater Marshall Chamber of Commerce Community Impact Award**.

ABOUT THIS PROJECT

This is a **rural trash disposal site for area residents** — designed to help neighbors get rid of small amounts of trash. **It's completely free to use. Leave your trash, donate what you can afford.** No contracts. No mandates. 100% voluntary — the community, the landowner, and Done With It all showing up by choice.

But it's more than just a dumpster. The site also offers a **free community swap area, metal recycling, tire recycling**, and an **aluminum can drop that benefits the Humane Society of Harrison County**. *We sort everything intentionally to keep as much out of the landfill as possible. (pg. 5)*

A few things to know up front: For area residents only — no hired junk haulers or contractors. **Small amounts of trash only. Closed Sundays.** *For full details on what's accepted, sorting instructions, suggested donations, location, and hours, see pages 4–6.*

Y'all have shown up every single month — covering every dollar of real costs through donations alone. To date, we've donated hundreds of hours of our own time to keep this running. As long as this project remains self-sustaining — meaning it doesn't cost us out of pocket — we will keep it going. The need keeps growing and so do we. Our long-term goal: dumpsters here 24/6. Thank you for supporting the Community Dumpster project!

Donations — How It Works

This project is **completely free to use**, but it only continues as long as donations cover the direct costs. Each dumpster run costs about **\$175 and 2.5 hours** round-trip (landfill fees, fuel, and other expenses). Over 30 months (Oct. 2023 - Mar. 2026) this community has donated enough to cover every single dollar — that's what makes it sustainable.



Suggested Donations (by volume). LIMIT: 1 truck-bed load of bagged trash or 2 large items per day.
 • No trailers or large dumps. Need more space? Rent a dumpster from us or use the landfill.

WHAT YOU'RE DROPPING OFF	SUGGESTED DONATION
A few bags of trash	\$1 – \$5
Monthly trash service — bagged household trash only	\$20
Recliner or full mattress (max. of 2-large items per day per household)	\$15 EACH
Couch or queen/king mattress (max. of 2-large items per day per household)	\$25 EACH
Truck bed of trash/construction debris (max. per household in 1-day)	\$25
Tires — no rim (2-passenger car/truck tire max. per household per month)	\$5 EACH
Tires — with rim (2-passenger car/truck tire max. per household per month)	\$15 EACH

HOW TO DONATE AT THE FRONT OF THE DUMPSTERS:

Sorting correctly keeps the site running, helps your neighbors, and diverts waste from landfills. **The back fence is a FREE community swap area** – take what you need, leave what you don't.



Ways We Sort

REUSABLE ITEMS/SWAP ZONE - put by the back fence (not in dumpster)

- 1** Useful items placed along back fence for community reuse. Furniture • Bikes • Kitchenware • Clothing • Lawn equipment • Electronics/TVs • Anything reusable. **Free for anyone to take!**

METAL RECYCLING - put by the back fence (not in dumpster)

- 2** Local haulers pick up scrap and take to local scrap yards. Bed frames • Grills • Tools • Appliances • Batteries • Fencing • Pots & pans • Anything 50%+ metal. **Free for pickup**

LANDFILL TRASH - PUT IN THE DUMPSTER

- 3** Securely bagged & tied household trash • Old/unusable furniture • Couches, chairs, recliners • Mattresses & box springs (lean neatly against the outside rear of the dumpster) • Flattened cardboard • Light construction debris. Taken to area landfills. **Our goal is to keep as much OUT of landfills as possible – proper sorting is key!**

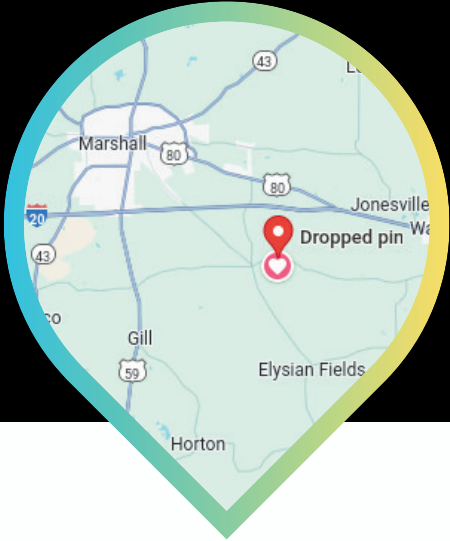
ALUMINUM CANS - bag separately and put by the back fence

- 4** Bag separately and leave by the fence. We donate to the Humane Society of Harrison County to help our furry friends. *Fun fact: recycling aluminum saves up to 95% of the energy needed to make new aluminum!*

TIRE RECYCLING - put by the back fence (not in dumpster)

- 5** Passenger car/truck tires only (max. 2 per household per month). We haul to **Arklatex Tire Processing, Linden TX** – shredded for land reclamation and new trees planted. **See a tire you want? Take it!**

Limit: 1 truck-bed load of bagged trash or 2 large items per day. No trailers or large dumps. Need more space? Rent a dumpster from us or use the landfill.
- 
Check signs: Always review the instructions posted before unloading.
- 
No dumpster diving.
- 
Cameras: 24/7 monitoring. Violating the rules = permanent ban from the site.
