

WASHINGTON COUNTY FAIR MUD BOG PIT RULES

1. Waivers must be signed by anyone participating in the event. Parents must sign for anyone under 16 years old.
2. Helmets are required, borrow one if you do not have one. Safety belts must be worn.
3. Doors must be on vehicles. Vehicles without doors must be approved by officials.
4. All vehicles other than A.T.V.s must be operated by persons of legal driving age (16).
5. Pee-Wees are 12 and under.
6. Numbers will be drawn for starting order.
7. If you miss your position in the starting, you will be disqualified. Let us know if there is a conflict with your starting order right away so we can accommodate multiple runs or multiple drivers in the same vehicle.
8. No running starts. No chains or spikes. Rubber tires only.
9. You are to start at the drop of the flag and stop when there is no more forward progress or when directed by an official.
10. Stay in the pit. No climbing the sides of the pit or you will be disqualified.
11. In the case of a tie in distance or time there will be a run off. The starting order of the run off will be decided by a coin toss.
12. If you end your run in the pit you will be pulled out by us. Vehicles should be in neutral and wheels straight. After being pulled out, you will not move until directed by a safety official. This is for the safety of the pull out crew.
13. You must designate where to hook up the pull out cable to your vehicle before you run. Clean out the bed of your truck before running.
14. You must have a strong hook up point accessible by clevis. Balls on factory bumpers are not acceptable. Consult officials for a good pullout point if your is questionable.
15. We are not responsible for any injuries or damage, you run at your own risk. No refunds for any reason.
16. Automatic disqualification for any of the following reasons: fighting, reckless driving, high speeds, wheelies, cookies, joy riding around the event grounds, or excessive intoxication. This also applies to spectators.
17. If officials believe you are too intoxicated, you will not run. No refund.
18. We have officials for every purpose and our decisions are final.
19. Classes consist of small large trucks and tire sizes. Full size/full width axles on a small truck will be regarded as a large truck. A small truck body on a full size chassis will be considered a large truck.
