The government of Canada issues over five hundred thousand work permits each year to temporary foreign workers. The work permit application process is a crucial step toward employment for foreign employees aiming to work in Canada. Therefore, it is essential to pass through appropriate pathways to obtain a Canadian work permit. Canadian work permit applications can be processed in several ways. Generally, to obtain work permits, an employer must submit a Labour Market Impact Assessment (LMIA), whereas, for other types of work permits, a relationship with Canada is required (previous education, spousal sponsorship, etc.). To get a work permit in Canada you need to submit an online application package with Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) or a Canadian visa office. Please note that for most work permits you will need to have a job offer from a Canadian employer before submitting your application. It is necessary to note that the procedure for applying for a Canadian work permit varies based on the type of work permit you seek. The first step is determining which kind of work permit is most appropriate for you. To get a work permit in Canada, it is usual to go through a two-step procedure to get a Canadian work permit. In most situations, candidates will first need to get a job offer in Canada before they can apply for a work permit. Step 1 – Most of the time, the initial step toward getting a Canadian work permit is to submit an application to Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC) for a Labour Market Impact Assessment (LMIA). Typically, a Canadian business must conduct domestic recruiting efforts and prove that Canadian permanent residents or citizens are not suited for the job before the position is filled. Step 2 – Following the issuance of a positive LMIA, the applicant may proceed to apply for a Canadian work visa based on the LMIA. Unless a worker holds an open work permit, work permits are employer-specific. If a worker wishes to change employers, they must first get a new Work Permit before engaging in any further employment activities in Canada. Please note that foreign workers may not need to have an LMIA or a job offer to apply for a work permit in some cases. This is true for those who have recently graduated from a Designated Learning Institute (DLI) or for the spouse of someone who is already in Canada on a work or study permit. 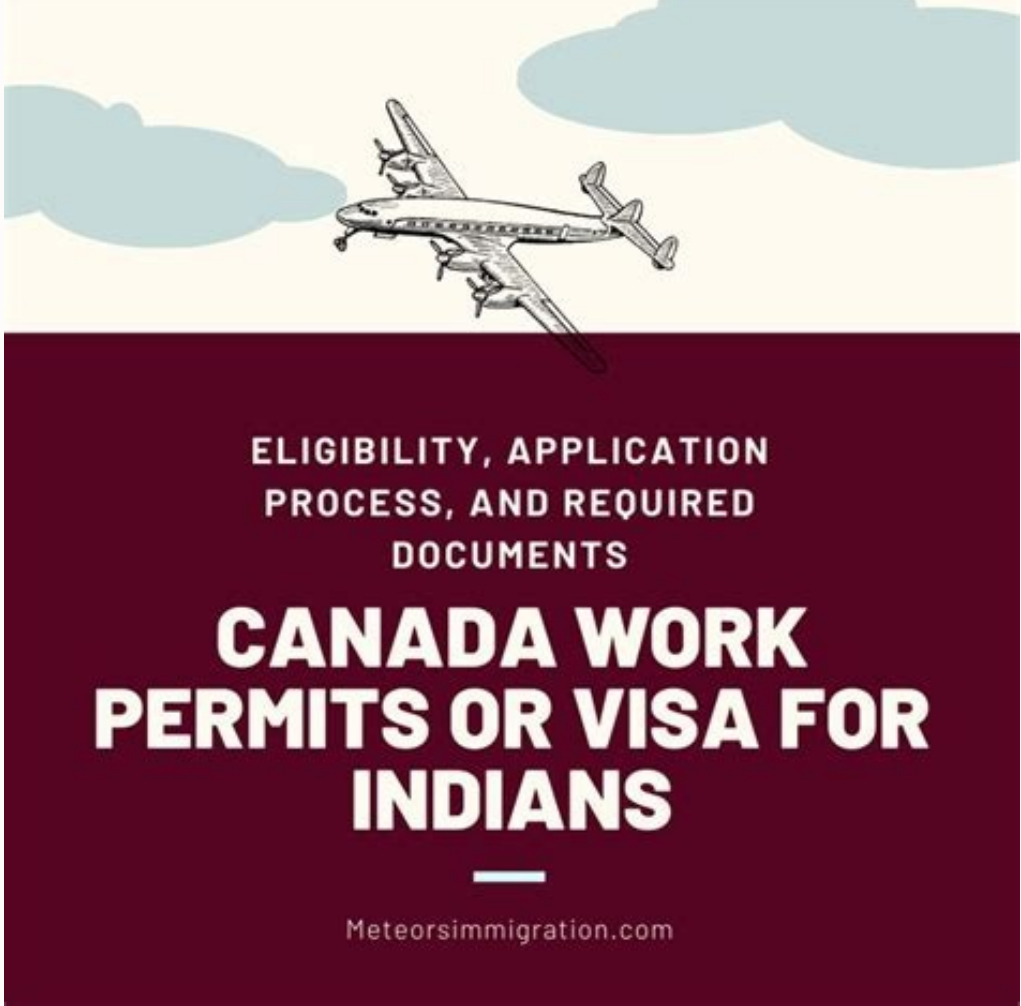

[ao.smith.hot.water.heater.error.codes](#) Work permit Canada requirements Here are the seven key eligibility requirements that all work permit applicants must meet to be considered for a work permit in Canada: Prove that you have plans to leave Canada: Regardless of the type of work permit you're applying for, you will need to demonstrate to a visa officer that you have a clear plan for leaving Canada once your work permit expires. Show that you have sufficient financial resources: You will need to provide evidence that you have enough money to support both yourself and any family members who will be accompanying you during your stay in Canada, and that you're able to cover the costs of your return trip home. Have a clean criminal record: To be eligible for a Canadian work permit, you'll need to show that you don't have a criminal record and are not a threat to Canada's national security. Be in good health: Depending on your individual circumstances, you may be required to undergo a medical examination to ensure that you are in good health.

Not work for ineligible or adult entertainment employers: It's important that you don't plan to work for an employer who has been marked as "ineligible" due to previous violations of the Temporary Foreign Worker Program, and you cannot work for employers who regularly offer adult entertainment services. Obey the law: You must not have a record of criminal activity, and you must be willing to obey all of Canada's laws and regulations. Provide any other requested documentation: You'll need to provide all of the necessary documentation to prove your eligibility for a Canadian work permit, which may include a variety of supporting materials such as medical records, employment contracts, and more. What documents are required to apply for a Canadian work permit? The document checklist you'll need for a Canadian work permit will vary depending on the work permit you're pursuing. As part of their work permit application, candidates may be required to submit the following required documents: Completed application forms Proof of status in Canada (if applicable) Family member's proof of status (if applicable) Labour Market Impact Assessment (if appropriate) A written offer of employment (if applicable) CV/ résumé Marriage certificate (if applicable) Police clearance certificates You may be asked to present police clearance certificates by the visa officer assessing your application. This document may be part of your application checklist and must be included with your first submission, depending on where you are applying. Applicants may be needed to show a police clearance certificate from each country where they have lived for 6 months or more since turning 18. With few exclusions, if you want to work in Canada for less than 6 months, you will most likely not need a health examination. You will need a medical exam if you plan to work in a job that requires close contact with people or if you are an agricultural worker who has been to certain countries. Medical checks must be done with an IRCC-designated panel physician. On the IRCC's Find a Panel Physician website, you can look for a panel physician near you. Applicants can undergo a medical examination before applying for a job. What is proof of eligibility to work in Canada? If you want to work in Canada, you'll need to be able to prove that you're eligible to do so. The Canadian government accepts a variety of documents as proof of eligibility, including a Canadian birth certificate, Canadian passport, Canadian citizenship certificate, Canadian certificate of permanent residence, Canadian open work permit, or receipt from Immigration Canada of an application for a post-graduate work permit. It's important to note that your proof of eligibility must be current and verified. That means that it cannot be expired, cancelled, or voided. Your offer of employment will be subject to verification of your eligibility, so it's important that you have the necessary documentation on hand when applying for jobs. Applying for work permit outside Canada: According to the guidelines, a foreign person may apply for an open work permit outside of Canada, at a port of entry, or after arriving in Canada. If your application is approved while you are outside Canada, you will get instructions on obtaining your work permit at the Canadian border (POB). If you submitted your application online, the letter would be available in your account. Or, if applied by mail, you would get a letter at your address. When to apply for a work permit? To apply for a work permit, you must first make an appointment with a specialist on the panel. An IRCC officer will contact you if you do not include your medical exam results with your application.

The officer will provide you with instructions on how to complete the exam and a date by which you must complete it. Evidence of financial means to stay in Canada and return to home country Proof of payment for applicable government fees Recent passport-sized photos All foreign nationals looking for a work permit in Canada must provide a passport-sized photo. The photo must meet IRCC's requirements. As a candidate, you can only apply for a work permit from inside Canada if you meet the following requirements: hold a valid study or work permit your spouse, common-law partner, or parents have a valid study or work permit you're eligible for a post-graduation work permit and your study permit is still valid you have a Temporary Resident Permit (TRP) that is valid for 6 months or more you've submitted an application and now waiting for a decision on your permanent residence from inside Canada you made a claim for refugee protection you're a trader, investor, francophone, entrepreneur, intra-company transferee, or professional under the Canada – United States – Mexico Agreement (CUSMA). The requirements in Canada are as follows: while some exemptions are applied, foreign individuals generally need to hold a valid work permit to work in Canada. The processing time begins when the IRCC receives your entire application and concludes until a decision is made. An employer-specific work permit authorizes foreign nationals to work following the work permit's criteria or limitations. It restricts a foreign national's ability to work in Canada for more than one employer and in just one position. You may refer to this link to get more information. If your work permit is due to expire or you need to modify the terms on it, you must apply to renew it or change the requirements. You need to apply for a work permit extension at least 30 days before your existing permit expires. Temporary foreign workers who want to extend their work permits must usually apply online. In the enquiry box, include "IEC work permit application withdrawal" and your application ID number. Once submitted, your application will be withdrawn, and you will receive a notification. Yes. Having two valid permits at the same time is possible under certain circumstances in Canada. For example, if you are participating in the International Experience Canada (IEC) program, you may be eligible to hold both a work permit and a study permit simultaneously. If you receive an invitation to apply through the IEC program, you can apply for a work permit even if you have a valid study permit. Alternatively, if you have a valid work permit through the IEC program, you may be able to apply for a study permit to further your education in Canada. Any LMIA request is normally processed by the human resources department in two months. The LMIA may proceed after the request is received.



The whole procedure, from start to finish, takes around three months. To apply for a Work Permit, you must have an active student visa and submit your application within 90 days of obtaining written proof that your academic program's criteria have been met.

With your application, you must provide the following supporting documents: Application to Change Conditions, Extend My Stay or Remain in Canada as a Worker (IMM 5710) A photocopy of your passport pages showing your passport number, the dates of issue and expiry, name and date of birth, and stamp by Canadian authorities on your most recent entry to Canada A document stating that you have completed the requirements of your academic program such as a final transcript, letter from your institution, or formal notification of graduation A receipt for the application fee If you receive a job offer before you receive your Post-Graduation Work Permit, you can start working if you have a valid off-campus work permit. A tourist is not permitted to pursue paid employment in Canada under the terms of his or her visitor visa. The only method to modify your travel visa is to reapply for a Canadian visa with a work permit. Within the first 90 days after your work permit expires, you may apply to have it reinstated. If you do this, you will be permitted to remain in Canada until further instructions are received but will be unable to work until your restored work permit is obtained. Otherwise, you must promptly depart Canada when your work permit expires. If you do not leave the country, you risk deportation and will be required to get permission to return from an immigration officer. It will take 59 days for your application to be granted if you submit it from inside Canada. The processing time will depend on the country you are applying from if you are applying from outside of Canada. A closed work permit costs CAD 155 per person, whereas an open work permit costs CAD 255. Extra costs will apply if you reinstate a work permit or apply as a performing artist group. Yes.

Due to COVID-19, Canadian Government temporarily allows visitors to apply online for a work permit within Canada.

In essence, a work permit cannot be canceled or revoked by your employer. They only provide notice that you are no longer employed by them to the government department in charge of immigration. Your study permit, or IRCC document, will include a document number in the upper right corner. On the upper right, it is a letter followed by 9 numerals, such as F123456789. A valid work permit is a document that allows foreign individual to legally work in Canada for the duration specified on the card. To acquire a work visa in Canada, foreign workers must be at least 18 years old. Except for those applying under the International Experience Canada (IEC) program, there is no upper age limit for the candidates. As a foreign national, you need a work permit when you engage in employment and receive compensation from a Canadian employer.

Your work permit change application must be submitted online.
