

At a Glance: An Affidavit of Support is a letter attesting to the legitimacy of a marriage and is required to remove the conditions on a green card obtained through marriage.

It should include the person's full name, relationship to the couple, how they know the couple, and details about their interaction and knowledge of the marriage. While family members are preferred, friends and religious leaders can also provide affidavits. The sample affidavit demonstrates the format and content required, and it is recommended to include a statement affirming the truthfulness of the letter. If you are applying for the conditions of your permanent residency to be removed, you will need to do everything you can to prove your marriage is legitimate. This includes providing an Affidavit of Support with your Form I-751. The more Affidavits of Support you can provide, the better chance of your success! But providing just any piece of paper won't do. You want to make sure the Affidavit of Support your friends and family provide is what the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) needs to approve your lawful permanent residency. To help you out, we provide Affidavit of Support samples below, which will help your friends and family create the Affidavit of Support you need! Your next step is to make sure your friends and family give you the best possible Affidavit of Support they can. Below we provide guidance of what should be in an Affidavit of Support and give you an Affidavit of Support sample. The most important part of the Affidavit of Support is that the person should give an account of their experience with you, your spouse, and your marriage.

They should also include reasons they believe the marriage was entered into in good faith. Let's take a look in more detail. Affidavit of Support Format An Affidavit of Support must contain the following: The person providing the Affidavit of Support's full name, address, date, and place of birth. They should explain what their relationship with you and your spouse is (for example friend or pastor). They must explain how they came to know you. Details of when and for how long he/she has known you. Information on the frequency that the person sees you and your spouse (for example at least once a month) date and signature. Your friends and family don't have to have the Affidavit of Support notarized. If the person providing the Affidavit of Support can't write a sentence using the lines of "I swear, under penalty of perjury, that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge." If you are a conditional permanent resident, you will have to have the conditions of your permanent residency removed before you will be regarded as a full lawful permanent resident. If you don't have these conditions removed, you will lose your green card. You would be a conditional permanent resident if you obtained your green card through marriage. Conditional permanent residency is only valid for the first two years after your marriage. Removal of Conditions from Your Green Card To have the conditions to your permanent residency removed before your conditional green card expires, you have to file a Form I-751, Petition to Remove the Conditions of Residence. Together with filing this form, you will have to show your marriage was "bona fide" (in good faith). activate dark mode in chrome android Basically, you have to show your marriage wasn't fraudulent, and you didn't only get married to get a green card. One way to show your marriage is legit is to have friends and family who are close to you provide an Affidavit of Support. This Affidavit of Support will be filed with your Form I-751. It is basically a letter in which the person attests to the fact that your marriage is legitimate and was entered into in "good faith." Who Needs an Affidavit of Support? You will need to provide an Affidavit of Support with your Form I-751 if you are a conditional permanent resident, and you want the conditions of your permanent residency to be removed. The Affidavit of Support should be provided by people who know you well and who can affirm they have first-hand knowledge of your marriage and personal life. The first choice will be to have a family member provide the Affidavit of Support. Since they've probably known you for the longest time, their testimony will be strong support that your marriage is legitimate.
