This includes providing an Affidavit of Support with your Form I-751. The more Affidavits of Support you can provide, the better chance of your success! You want to make sure the Affidavit of Support your friends and family provide is what the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) needs to approve your lawful permanent residency. Below we provide guidance of what should be in an Affidavit of Support and give you an Affidavit of Support sample. The most important part of the Affidavit of Support is that the person should give an account of their experience with you, your spouse, your marriage.

Affidavit of Support Format An Affidavit of Support must contain the following: The person providing the Affidavit of Support's full name, address, date, and place of birth They should explain what their relationship with you and your spouse is (for example, friend or pastor) They must explain how they came to know you Details of when and for how long he/she has known you Information on the frequency that the person sees you and your spouse (for example, at least once a month) Date and signature. Your friends and family don't have to have the Affidavit of Support notarized, but it could be a good idea to include a statement swearing to the letter's validity. For example, the person providing the Affidavit of Support can include a sentence along the lines of "I swear, under penalty of perjury, that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge." Affidavit of Support Sample [The name and address of the person providing the Affidavit of Support should be typed at the top of the letter. Conditional permanent residency is only valid for the first two years after your marriage. Removal of Conditions from Your Green Card To have the conditions to your permanent residency removed before your conditional green card expires, you will have to file a Form I-751, Petition to Remove the Conditions of Residence. Together with filing this form, you will have to show your marriage was "bona fide" (in good faith). activate dark mode in chrome and android Basically, you have to show your marriage wasn't fraudulent, and you didn't only get married to get a green card. One way to show your marriage is legit is to have friends and family who are close to you provide an Affidavit of Support. This Affidavit of Support will be filed with your Form I-751. It is basically a letter in which the person attests to the fact that your marriage is legitimate and was entered into in "good faith." Who Needs an Affidavit of Support? The first choice will be to have a family member provide the Affidavit of Support. Since they've probably known you for the longest time, their testimony will be strong support that your marriage is legitimate.
