Adult Division (A) – all entries in this department are classified as adult entries. This is the default division; **no age/grade letters should be added**. Entry codes are in brackets [ ]. Youth may enter in Dept. 11, Section B-12

1. Read General Rules, follow all rules and regulations.
2. One pint glass jars with lids must be used to show grain in Classes 1, 2, 7-9, 11-13.
3. **EXHIBITS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED** if the correct number of specimens is not displayed.
4. Grains grown since the close of the previous year's Fair (Sept. 21, 2018); winter wheat, etc. may be entered.
5. Paper plates will be supplied where needed.
6. All entries in this department will be sold at auction unless picked up by the entrant or designee between 4 and 5 p.m. on Saturday.
7. An entrant placing entries in Department 11 (Youth Under 19), Section B-12 may NOT make duplicate entries in this department. Such entries will be disqualified.
8. **Premiums in all classes: \$5.00, \$4.00, \$3.00**

Class 6 - Any native grain except Barley or Buckwheat
