Treasurer's Report for November Meeting & Fall Auction

All I can say is WOW! What a wonderful time November was for the club. We started off already on a good note and ended the month and a great one. Our meeting was so fun and informative and then the auction, what a successful one it was. Let us start with where we left off with the last report. We started with a balance of \$684.15. At the meeting we had:

This left us with a balance of \$606.60 going into the auction. From there, the auctions amounts were:

That left us with a cashbox balance of \$3,494.10. If we take that balance and minus the float and the previous balance (though factored into that balance was the cost of supplies and the printer), it means we brought in a little over \$2,400.00 for the club from the auction. What a fantastic turnout, help and participation by all, we are all amazing. Tonight, I am giving in a deposit of \$2,894.00 for the bank account. Our bank account had a previous balance of \$2103.47. Since the last report we have had:
