S.C.A.A.S. Auction Rules



- 1. No Illegal Animals or Plants (native or invasive not allowed)
- 2. No Used Electronics
- 3. All fish must be bagged appropriately in fish bags *NO ZIPLOCKS* with enough water and air to last several hours. Fish bags are available during and prior to auction for sale by SCAAS. Any fish not bagged properly will be given back to seller to fix or charged a \$2 re-bagging fee.
- 4. All items must be clearly labelled with our stickers which holds your seller number and table number
- 5. Make sure your form has your correct email address name and address in case you are unable to stay until end for payment.
- 6. All bag must be clearly labelled with item name and quantity for Auctioneers to be able to identify easily
- 7. All reserve Bids **MUST** be written on Bags clearly by Label ID
- 8. CASH SALE ONLY!
- 9. One Seller number per household, a second number will be issued once the first page is full.
- 10. You **CANNOT** bid up your own item. **ANYONE** found doing so will be asked to leave and all remaining items they have for sale will be removed from the auction.
- 11. You do not need to be a Club member to buy or sell
- 12. Sellers **MUST** register by 9:30am and all items are to be labelled and on tables by 9:45am so we can start promptly at 10:00am
- 13. Items to be auctioned may be fish, plants, New or gently used *CLEAN* aquarium decorations, new electronics only, Used fish tanks 30gals and Under as long as they have no chips, cracks and are clean and dry.
- 14. No Open containers of fish food, medication will be allowed nor expired products
- 15. Once items are on the table for auction they **CANNOT** be withdrawn
- 16. Payments by buyers are due immediately in cash to runners
- 17. SCAAS assumes **NO** liability or responsibility for any items bought or sold
- 18. All sales are final and at discretion of auctioneer
- 19. **ANY** item can be **BUMPED** to next in line for a \$2.00 fee. Please let any member of SCAAS know what item you want bumped and they will retrieve it from table and give to auctioneer.
- 20. Rudeness will **NOT** be tolerated, any buyer or seller who is action inappropriately will be asked to leave.


