

Water Changes – Alternative Opinion By Richard Matthie

Our hobby is dependent on water and its chemical makeup, pH, Nitrates, and Ammonia etc. We set up a new aquarium and we "Cycle" the water. Everyone's tap water is different depending on the water source it's drawn from. Cycling can take 3 days to couple of weeks. It is just part of keeping and breeding our fish. Once we have every chemical level to our liking, we add fish. This process we all know, accept and live by.

A lot has been written about "weekly" water changes. Take out 25%, 50% and some people advocate 75% and replace it with "new" water. Do you know what your tap water chemical make-up is? Our water treatment plants play around with chlorine levels, fluoride and other parameters to make our water "safe" for drinking on daily basis. Is the water fish safe though? You do a big water change. You replace it with water out of the tap. What is your tank water chemical make-up now? We put a dechlorinator like Aqua Safe in the new water to control the chlorine but what about the other chemical parameters?

How many times have we read a post saying" Help! My Fish Are Dying "after a BIG water change. Your tank isn't cycled any more. Your water parameters are out of the acceptable levels. The good bacteria level had been reduced to low levels. Your fish can't take the change and pass away. We need to think about what we are adding to our tanks. You're playing dangerously if you have high value fish or you're doing a major breeding program.

So, what is the answer and proper procedure? For me the answer is no water changes. I don't do weekly changes just replace water that has been evaporated. I'm sure everyone that keeps a large amount of tanks has their own system. I have over 25 tanks (more getting added all the time for breeding purposes). Twice a week, I top up the water level. I use tap water with Aqua Safe added. The most I add to any tank is 1.5 gallons. My big 75 gallon tanks would never be bothered by that amount in the slightest. My 10 gallon guppy breeding tanks might get a quarter gallon added max (that's 3% new water). A low amount of new tap water doesn't upset your water chemistry like adding 25%, 50% or 75% new water. You don't dilute your bacteria level very much. Your tank is basically still cycled. Your fish can handle a very slight change. I have tanks that I have had in operation for 4 years and it's very rare to lose a fish.

So, what about when a tank just gets too dirty? Water clarity is a high importance to me. When it's time to overhaul a tank, I don't drain it. The fish are moved to another tank. Heater, filters, rocks and plants are removed. The gravel or sand is stirred up releasing the dirt trapped. I put a strong power filter on the tank and filter out the contaminants. Over usually 3 days. I keep stirring the tank until the water is clear. Why do all this? Wouldn't it be easier to just drain it, clean the tank and gravel and set it back up? Easy isn't always the best way. It's faster to tear a tank down and put it back together with "NEW" water. That's the catch. New water means cycling the tank all over. For me keeping the tank set up and filtering out the dirt means my tank stays cycled. Water parameters don't change. I also don't have a water bill (\$\$\$) for the water that would have been replaced.


Agree with me or disagree with my logic, this is what works for me. Oh, one last thing, I've been keeping and breeding fish for over 50 years. I have a civil engineering background dealing with water treatment plants and it has helped with my fish addiction.
