



Housing Programs



For over 20 years, ACF of Metro Atlanta has been helping families secure safe and stable housing. We provide Rapid Re-Housing, rent and utility assistance, and referral services to families in need throughout the City of Atlanta and the counties of DeKalb, Henry, Clayton, and Cobb.

Eligible expenses include rent, mortgage payments, and utilities such as gas, water, and electricity.

Funding support from participating cities and counties, as well as individual and corporate donors, has enabled us to serve more than 1,400 families in 2019 alone. Qualified applicants may receive assistance for a limited time, based on individual circumstances and funding availability. We work in collaboration with partner agencies to connect families to additional resources. Our housing support prioritizes individuals and families facing financial hardship, homelessness, or housing instability, including those living with HIV+.

We are currently expanding our impact with two new housing initiatives. The first focuses on developing housing for Active Seniors ages 55+. The second initiative involves the re-purposing of properties to provide housing, counseling, and life-skills training for students and families experiencing homelessness and enrolled in public schools in Clayton County.
