



The Housing Authority of the City of Winston-Salem (HAWS) has been awarded 31 Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHVs) by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). HAWS has partnered with the Winston-Salem Forsyth County Continuum of Care (CoC). The CoC will manage the verification of eligibility to qualify for an EHV Voucher and make direct referrals of EHV eligible families to HAWS. To be eligible for an EHV Voucher, the applicant must meet income restrictions and fall into one of the four eligibility categories:

1. Individuals or families who are homeless (and defined by law under the McKinney - Vento Homeless Assistance Act);
2. Individuals or families who are at-risk of homelessness;
3. Individuals or families who are fleeing or attempting to flee, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or human trafficking; or
4. Recently homeless (as determined by the CoC)

If you fall into one of the categories above and to determine if you are eligible for an EHV Voucher, please contact the **Central Intake Center (CIC) at 336 721-9327**. Once the CIC has determined that you are eligible for an EHV Voucher, the CIC will inform the Housing Authority of your eligibility.
