Annual Assessment Letters were Mailed in December



Because of the escalating costs of postage, the Board combined its notice of the Annual Assessment, due in March, along with the December mailing about the Annual Meeting. The Assessment will remain at \$650 per household and is the only source of revenue to manage the pool, and pay for lighting, utilities, repairs, insurance, and ground maintenance. There will be no more snail mail reminders.

There are multiple options for payment: By check in full by April 1; in two installments of \$325 each with the first installment on March 1 and the second on April 1; by credit card through your Member Splash account; or by Zelle in one of two installments treasurer@lakeridgewest.org Please include your name and address in the memo field.

Those who pay in full by April 1 will receive 20 daily guest passes for either children or adults for use throughout the summer. In accordance with our bylaws, failure to pay the Assessment by April 1 will result in a \$50 late charge and other potential penalties..
