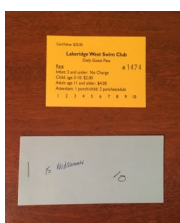


Our Lakeridge West activities and events are run by volunteers, just like the Board is comprised of volunteers. Here are some ideas for this summer that need assistance:
