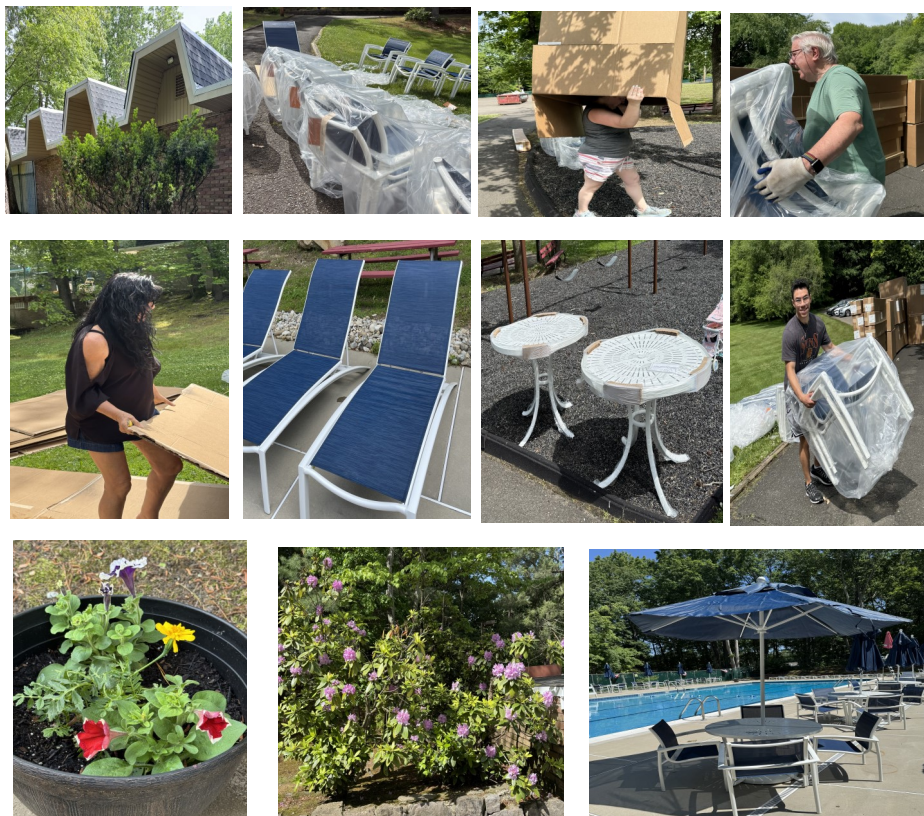


LWCA Swim Club Gets a Facelift
