#### **Recycling Patterns Will Change in August**



Middlesex County is switching to Single Stream Recycling, beginning August 4. All homeowners will receive a 95-gallon rolling cart in which you combine recyclables that we previously separated— plastics, glass, cardboard, mixed paper, and cans. Greasy or food contaminated items such as pizza boxes do NOT belong in recycling. Please remember this at our Swim Club also!

You are welcome to keep your old recycling containers for your household use, or put it in the new recycling container to return it to the Middlesex County Improvement Authority. With the switch to the Automated Side Load, anything outside the new recycling container will not be picked up. Authorities say the recycling schedule will remain the same.
