Lifeguards Keep Skills Up-to-Date



Although all our lifeguards are properly certified, they refresh their skills regularly to keep our residents safe. On a recent morning, pool manager Alyah Diab conducted practice drills for LWCA staff. Lifeguard drills include scanning the pool, timed rescues, practicing team and solo rescues, communication, and quick response. The guards practice in shallow and deep water, using rescue tubes and working with an unresponsive, passive victim.

May we never face these emergencies, but it's good to know LWCA takes our safety seriously. Here are some of the training photos.



Of course, safety is not just the job of lifeguards. Swim at a depth you are comfortable in, keep an eye on your children, avoid excessive horseplay and comply with pool regulations.
