Old Bridge Police to Present at January 24 Annual Meeting



Detective Michael Bucci of the Old Bridge Police Department and Michael Petschauer, coordinator of the Office of Emergency Management, will be featured speakers at the Annual Meeting of the Lakeridge West Community Association. The meeting will be held on Saturday, January 24, from 10 am to noon at the Old Bridge Civic Center.

Det. Bucci will address issues such as home security, identity theft, and fraud protection. Mr. Petschauer will provide an overview of Old Bridge's state-approved emergency operations plan, including our Code RED safety alert system.

After their presentations, homeowners will have an opportunity to ask questions and address general concerns about public safety. The business portion of LWCA's Annual Meeting will then follow the Police Department.

Annual Meeting Also Includes Summary on LWCA Operations & Finance



In addition to the Police Department presentation described above, LWCA President Karen Paton will offer an overview of the 2025 season, the state of LWCA's finances, plans for the 2026 season, and capital needs and expenses. The 2026 proposed budget will be presented and voted upon by homeowners.

Ms. Paton will also introduce the new Photo ID/Barcode pool entry system that will be utilized for the 2026 pool system. This system is designed to strengthen safety and security of all members and guests. In order to get a headstart on this process, Photo IDs will be created at the Annual Meeting and other scheduled times later in the year. All adult residents must present proof of residency.

Residents will also elect members to fill any vacancies on the Board of Trustees. As mentioned above, the Annual Meeting will be held on Saturday, January 24, from 10 am to noon at the Old Bridge Civic Center.
