- take seriously the major legal responsibilities of serving on a board, including and especially the fiduciary role
- work in good faith with staff and other board members as partners towards achievement of our mission stay and informed about what's going on in the organization:
 - asking questions and request information,
 - participating in and take responsibility for making decisions on issues, policies, and other board matters
