# **Grant Update**



In the fall of 2020, we received a grant from NIC, Niagara Investment in Culture, for our project of "Expanding Our Impact: The Value of Reaching Out" which allowed us to bring the Arts to our local seniors and teens.

We provided classroom instruction for more than twenty local senior residents. Also, we delivered 36 art kits to Gilmore Lodge - Fort Erie, in December giving them the Joy of ART during their facility lockdown.

We collaborated with our local high school, Greater Fort Erie Secondary School, where 8 students had to opportunity to participate in a 6-week multimedia art class.

The Fort Erie Arts Council and two of our artists, Donna MacLeod and Lori Burke participated in International Art and Found Day, which is in it's 6th year. It's a day when artists all over the world leave a piece of art in their community to spread a little happiness. They chose one or more of your artworks big or small – it could be a painting, photograph, drawing, handmade item, music album etc.

The artist leaves a note on the inside with a little information about the piece and themselves. They then package it up safely with a note taped to the outside with the hashtag #ArtandFoundDay.
