☞ Pacifiers, bottles, sippy cups, burp cloths, etc.

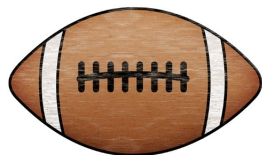
These donations will be given away at the event in addition to items purchased through the grant.

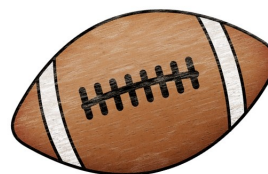
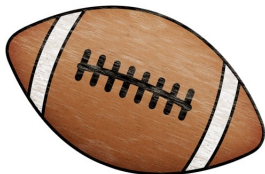
