The Board would like to remind all our members that your Lodge depends on your participation to operate. We also welcome your input on what you need to bring you in more.

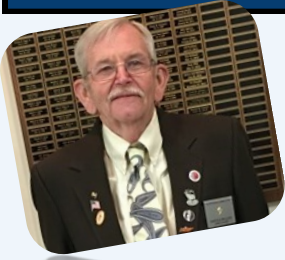

A SIMPLE PRAYER FOR HEALING

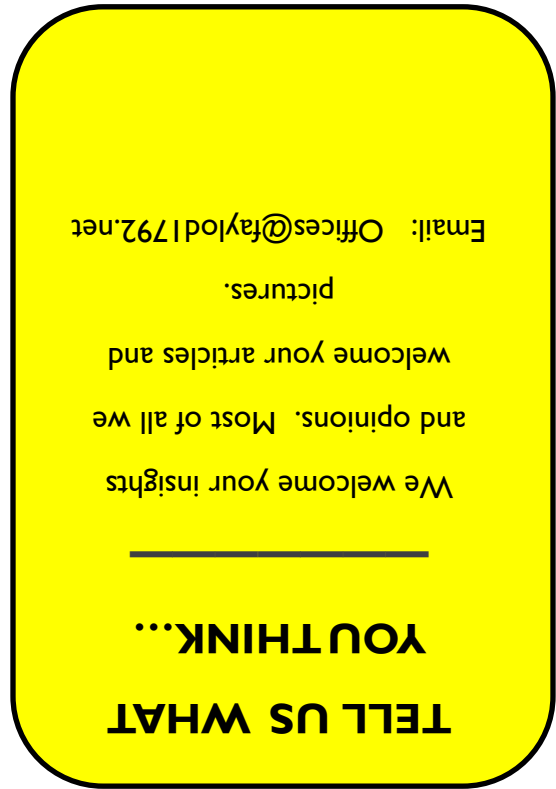
Lord of Heaven,
