# Warfare Prayer Against Anxiety and Fear



Father God, in the name of Jesus Christ, I take authority over the spirit of fear and anxiety that has tried to torment my mind, sabotage my peace, and steal my sleep. I decree and declare: NO MORE! I belong to the Lord, and I will not be shaken.

Your Word says in 2 Timothy 1:7 that You have not given me a spirit of fear, but of power, love, and a sound mind. I rise up in that power now! I command every tormenting thought, every cycle of panic, and every lie from the pit of hell to bow to the name of Jesus.

## I speak **Psalm 91** over my life:

"He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty... I will not be afraid of the terror by night, nor of the arrow that flies by day." I take refuge in Your presence, O God! Your faithfulness is my shield and rampart.
