

1. Breaking Curses:

2. Prayer of Repentance:

I repent for every word I have spoken over myself in agreement with the spirit of death and destruction. Forgive me for allowing the enemy to influence my thinking, causing me to neglect the truth of who I am in Christ.

I renounce every thought of unworthiness and rejection. I renounce self-hatred and self-doubt that I have clung to as my identity. I break every agreement with the enemy's lies, and I choose to align my heart and mind with Your truth, Lord.

In the mighty name of Jesus, I ask for Your cleansing power to wash me and renew me. Restore my heart, mind, and soul to the place of wholeness, healing, and peace. I receive Your forgiveness and declare that I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus.

3. Decree:

In the name of Jesus, I decree that you are fearfully and wonderfully made (Psalm 139:14). I declare that your life is precious in the sight of God. No weapon formed against you will

prosper (Isaiah 54:17). Every lie of the enemy that has tried to diminish your value, every voice of accusation that has told you you are worthless, is silenced now.

I decree that you are a beloved child of God, created with purpose, and there is no lack of His love for you. I declare over you that you are not defined by your past, your mistakes, or your wounds. Your identity is rooted in Christ alone—who says you are His masterpiece (Ephesians 2:10).

I speak life to your thoughts, and I call forth a fresh anointing to restore your sense of self-worth.

4. Blessings:

I speak the blessing of peace over your heart. I release the joy of the Lord to fill your soul and renew your mind. I bless your emotions with healing, your thoughts with clarity, and your body with strength.

May the Spirit of the Lord surround you, leading you into a place of deep identity in Christ. May you come to know, beyond any shadow of a doubt, that you are loved with an everlasting love.

I bless you with confidence that flows from knowing that you are more than a conqueror in Christ Jesus.

May the Lord surround you with His favor like a shield. May His love wash over every wound, and may His truth be a foundation beneath your feet.
