Rules and Instructions

- 1. High school seniors or enrolled college students are eligible for this scholarship.
- 2. Applicants shall have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 and shall attend college or a technical institute in Louisiana.
- 3. One scholarship will be awarded.
- 4. The applicant shall not be a current reigning queen of any fair or festival.
- 5. The scholarship shall be a one-time payment of \$500.00.
- 6. Scholarship awards shall be announced in May 2024.
- 7. A signed letter of recommendation from a teacher or advisor shall accompany the Application.
- 8. Applicant shall be involved in local school programs, contribute to the community and display leadership abilities.
- 9. Prior scholarship recipients are ineligible to apply for one year.
- 10. Children of the Scholarship Committee are not ineligible to apply.
- 11. Application and supporting documentation regarding the scholarship shall be mailed to the address below and received by the deadline of April 15, 2024.
- 12. Must be a resident of the State of Louisiana.
