# **Correspondence Reports:**

**Administrator**: spoken and written. Grace explained that Mike Censke and she have been writing a Technical Assistant grant through NACD. This grant would support the NRCS in Berrien, Cass and St. Joseph counties.

**NRCS**: Charles spoke about his contracts and payments he is making for the producers that completed their contracts this past year. He explained more about the Technical grant and that he felt that 1.8 Million dollars has been brought to the county through the federal programs.

- Handbook Changes: Grace discussed the cost of the NRCS admin hours given to the staff. She recommended that only the full time or CTAI type grant employees receive this benefit. No action was taken. The board will discuss next month.

- Michigan Class: Jeff Anderson presented the information about the financial capabilities of the program. All board members present had many questions and comments. The board decided to wait until Blasius and Hironimus are present before making a final decision. This was once again tabled until next month

#### **New Business:**

- Wages 2025: During the Budget hearing Higgins made a motion to accept the budget as presented. This included wage increases within the grant proposal and grant acceptance. However, the MAEAP and CTAI grant language has not been sent at this time. Higgins motioned to give the CTAI position a \$0.50 increase provided the employee meets with the Administrator and NRCS DC to discuss tardiness, after 30 days of satisfactory work, the raise will be given. Blasius second. Motion passed. MAEAP and Administrator wages were not discussed.
