Important Information

Drop off & Pick up -

- 1. Adults drop off your child at the half door to a staff member and pick up at the half door from a staff member. Please drop off your child off by 9am and pick your child up at 3pm, unless otherwise scheduled.
- 2. Sign your child in and out with the actual time and full signature.
- 3. Aftercare parents may go to playground/activity room to pick up their child.

- 3. Also, send clean, fresh water in your child's water bottle each morning.

School Breaks -

Throughout the school year MVM follows the APS district calendar and snow day/delay schedule (no ½ day class on a delay day).

Except: Staff In-Service Monday's, which fall after long holidays off. In return for these in-service days we are open on Election Day, Veteran's day & the Vernal Holiday. Our staff works on these days to do staff meetings, deep clean and sanitize the classrooms, put out new work, and plan for the upcoming weeks. Please become aware of when In-service days take place.
