

The regular monthly meeting of the Greenfield Township Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 pm with the pledge of Allegiance.

The roll call was Supervisor Mancuso present, Supervisor Bonczkiewicz present, Supervisor Jenkins present, Attorney Favreau present, Secretary Brewer present, Treasurer Rudalavage present. A Supervisor's quorum was present, so the meeting was able to proceed. There were no corrections to the minutes of the March 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting, so the minutes stood approved as distributed.

The Township departments read or stated verbally their reports as available.

Jennifer Warren commented on the possible effects of data centers in the Township. After those comments Solicitor Favreau explained the purpose of regulating Data centers by restricting them to Industrial Zones by Ordinance. He said in the future the intermunicipal Zoning Ordinance will prohibit any data centers to be built in Greenfield Township. A Mr. Stepanianis also commented on Data Centers.

Supervisor Mancuso opened the hearing to consider for adoption the proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to define, permit, and regulate data centers. After answering questions from the public and an explanation by Solicitor Favreau, Supervisor Jenkins moved to adopt the ordinance. Supervisor Bonczkiewicz seconded the motion. The motion passed with a voice vote with all Supervisors present voting yes.

Supervisor Bonczkiewicz moved to unseal the one bid for Sale and Purchase of a Vibratory Roller for Greenfield Township. Supervisor Mancuso seconded that motion. The motion passed with a voice vote with all Supervisors present voting yes.

Supervisor Mancuso moved to adopt a resolution to declare certain Township Property equipment as surplus and authorizing its sale by public auction. Supervisor Jenkins seconded that motion. The motion passed with a voice vote with all Supervisors present voting yes.

Supervisor Jenkins moved to appoint Lori Pawluck to the board of auditors. Supervisor Bonczkiewicz seconded the motion. The motion passed with a voice vote with all Supervisors present voting yes.

Trevor Walczak explained his request for a zoning change for a Solar farm. Solicitor Favreau explained why the Township is reluctant to approve the request in order not to set a precedent. Solicitor Favreau explained to Mr. Walczak the process for filing for a variance to the Zoning Board. A person who did not legibly print his name on the sign in sheet noted that a person is living in a condemned building off Shust Road. The Solicitor recommended that he notify NEIC to address the issue.

Supervisor Bonczkiewicz moved to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Jenkins seconded that motion. The motion passed with a voice vote with all Supervisors present voting yes. The meeting was adjourned at 7:35 pm.
