

## Greenfield Township Supervisors' Meeting – August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022 Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly meeting of the Greenfield Township Supervisors was called to order at 8:01 pm with the pledge of Allegiance.

The roll call was Supervisor Slebodnik present, Supervisor Totsky present, Supervisor Mancuso present via phone, Attorney Casper present, Secretary Brewer present. A Supervisor's quorum was present, so the meeting was able to proceed.

There were no corrections to the minutes of the July 5<sup>th</sup> meeting by the Supervisors, so the minutes stood approved as distributed.

The Township departments read or stated verbally their reports as available.

There were no comments from the public on Agenda items.

Supervisor Totsky moved to accept the bid from Chris Phillips for the maintenance for the exterior of the Municipal building. Supervisor Slebodnik seconded that motion. The motion passed with a voice vote with all Supervisors present voting yes.

The Board responded that it is a Sewer Authority issue. George Fezy expressed his concern on the water run-off from Altier Lane. Solicitor Casper responded with an update.
