

Greenfield Township Supervisors' Meeting – June 9th 2020

Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly meeting of the Greenfield Township Supervisors was called to order at 8:04 pm by Chairperson Totsky with the pledge of Allegiance.

The roll call was Supervisor Totsky present, Supervisor Slebodnik present, Supervisor Evans absent, Attorney Casper absent, Treasurer Mike Mancuso present, Secretary Chaz Brewer present. A Supervisor's quorum was present so the meeting was able to proceed.

There were no corrections to the minutes of the May 5rd meeting so the minutes stood approved as distributed.

The Township reports were read or stated verbally.

There were no agenda items therefore there were no public comments.

Betty Zuk from Lake Avenue complained about the road conditions and road maintenance. The Supervisors responded with a plan to correct the situation starting with the roads being surveyed.

Mike Mazza commented that there was no Zoning report and also requested that Lee Road be changed to Lee Drive with a cul-de-sac.

Jerry Snyder commented on Police Department support, on restarting recycling, on the missing Supervisor, and on the good job done on Pierce Road.

Supervisor Totsky moved to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Slebodnik seconded that motion. There was no discussion and the motion passed with a voice vote with all Supervisors voting yes. The meeting was adjourned at 8:23 pm.
