

## **Greenfield Township Supervisors' Meeting – May 5<sup>th</sup> 2020**

Due to the Public Health Emergency surrounding the spread of COVID-19 the meeting was live streamed via Zoom for the public

### **Meeting Minutes**

The regular monthly meeting of the Greenfield Township Supervisors was called to order at 8:05 pm with Supervisor Totsky making an opening statement with regard to the Public Health Emergency surrounding the spread of COVID-19 then followed by the pledge of Allegiance.

The roll call was Supervisor Totsky present, Supervisor Slobodnik present, Supervisor Evans present, Attorney Casper present, Treasurer Mike Mancuso present, Secretary Chaz Brewer present. A Supervisor's quorum was present so the meeting was able to proceed.

There were no corrections to the minutes of the April 7<sup>rd</sup> meeting so the minutes stood approved as distributed.

The Township reports were read or stated verbally.

During the Supervisor's report Supervisor Totsky noted that due to the primary election on June 2<sup>nd</sup> that the next meeting will be on June 9<sup>th</sup>.

There was no public input on Agenda items.

Supervisor Slobodnik moved to execute PENNDOT form M-950K (3-19) Highway Occupancy Permit Obligation Bond. It was seconded by Supervisor Totsky and was passed by a voice vote with all Supervisors voting yes.

Supervisor Totsky read a letter from Mike Mazza Jr stating that citizen's rights were violated because the meeting was live streamed via Zoom for the public due to the Public Health Emergency surrounding the spread of COVID-19. Supervisor stated that the Township was following Governor Wolf's orders. There were no other public comments.

Supervisor Totsky moved to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Evans seconded that motion. There was no discussion and the motion passed with a voice vote with all Supervisors voting yes. The meeting was adjourned at 8:16 pm.
