

ORDINANCE NO. 7- 73


AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE BID OF OHIO ROAD PAVING COMPANY FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER, OHIO AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring herein, as follows:


1. That the bid of Ohio Road Paving Company of 8 E. Long Street, Columbus, Ohio, in the amount of \$27,156.30 for the improvement of certain streets in the Village of Spencer, Ohio in accordance with the detailed plans and specifications on file with the Village Clerk and previously approved by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, be and the same hereby is deemed to be the lowest and best bid and is hereby accepted.
2. That this Ordinance, the legal notice, the plans and specifications and the bid of Ohio Road Paving Company shall serve as the written contract for such street improvement between Ohio Road Paving Company and the Village of Spencer, Ohio upon the contractor furnishing to the Village Clerk evidence of having in force the usual insurance coverage which will fully protect the Village from any and all claims, demands or causes of action which may arise out of said improvement.
3. Payment for said road improvement shall be made by the Clerk to the contractor upon satisfactory completion of the road improvement from the appropriate fund.

4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and for the particular reason that it is necessary to enter into a road improvement contract immediately so as to complete the road improvement during the fall season of 1973, and that this ordinance will be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
