

ORDINANCE NO. 5- 73

AN ORDINANCE BANNING SEMI-TRACTORS AND OTHER TRUCKS WITH A FIVE TON OR OVER LOAD CAPACITY FROM CERTAIN STREETS IN THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, It has come to the attention of the Spencer Village Council that certain semi-tractors and other heavy trucks have been using side streets in the Village of Spencer and because of the weight of said trucks are causing serious damage to said streets; and

WHEREAS, it is not necessary for such trucks to use the village side streets except for local delivery or pick up;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. All semi-tractors and other trucks with a five ton or over load capacity, shall be banned from the use of the following streets, except when on a local delivery or pick up upon said streets, to-wit:

West end of Forest Street from Reed Street

Reed Street

Billman Street

Rainbow Street

Lorain Street

Jefferson Street

Washington Street

Jackson Street

School Street

Liberty Street.

Appropriate signs shall be placed upon said streets notifying users thereof that trucks are banned.

2. Whoever shall violate Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be fined not more than \$50.00.

3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and for the particular reason that it is necessary to prevent further damage to the Village Streets by unwarranted use of trucks thereon, and that this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
