

ORDINANCE NO. 4 73

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LITTERING, ASSESSING A PENALTY THEREFOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. No person shall place or dispose of, in any manner, any garbage, waste, or peelings of vegetables or fruits, rubbish, ashes, cans, bottles, wire, paper, cartons, boxes, parts of automobiles, wagons, furniture, glass, oil, or anything else of an unsightly or unsanitary nature along or near or on any public road, street, parkway, park drive, public park, highway, ditch, or any land adjoining any public road or highway or ditch within the Village of Spencer, Ohio except on land or in containers provided for the collection of such materials, unless directed to do so by public officials on special clean-up days.


2. Whoever violates Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be fined not more than \$50.00.

3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and for the particular reason that it is necessary to control littering near and upon the public streets of Spencer, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
