

ORDINANCE 11 -74

AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE LOWEST AND  
BEST BID FOR A NEW POLICE CAR, AND TO  
DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of  
Spencer, Ohio, three - fourths of its members concurring  
herein, as follows:

1. That the bid of Geo. G. Spitzer Motors of  
788 Main Street Grafton, Ohio 44044 for the sale to  
the Village of Spencer of a new police car in accordance  
with the Village Specifications in the amount of \$ 4,663.25  
is hereby declared to be the lowest and best  
bid.

2. That the Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized  
and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of  
said new police car with the successful bidder and to  
pay the successful bidder the sum of \$ 4,663.25  
which shall be charged to the Safety Fund.

3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be  
an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the  
public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village  
of Spencer, Ohio and for the particular reason that a new  
police car is immediately necessary to maintain proper  
police protection, and that this ordinance shall be in full  
force and effect from and after its passage.
