

ORDINANCE NO. 9-74

AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE LOWEST AND BEST
BID FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN AMBULANCE, TO
ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF
SAME AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of
Spencer, Ohio, three - fourths of its members concurring
herein, as follows:

1. That the bid of Freyer Superior Coach Sales,
Inc. of 619 Turner Avenue, Lima, Ohio 45804 in the amount
of \$21,220.00 for the sale to the Village of Spencer of an
Ambulance as per the plans and specifications now on file
with the village clerk for said ambulance, is hereby declared
to be the lowest and best bid and is accepted by the Village
of Spencer subject to negotiating a price reduction if certain
optional extra equipment is deleted from said ambulance by
order of the Village.

2. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized
and directed to enter into a proper sales agreement and
contract with Freyer Superior Coach Sales, Inc. for the
purchase of said ambulance.

3. The purchase price of \$21,220.00 or less is
hereby authorized to be paid to the successful bidder and
shall be charged to the appropriate fund.

4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the
public health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer,
Ohio and for the particular reason that the immediate acquisition
of said ambulance will save the Village a considerable sum
of money and will commence the public protection for the

Village at the earliest possible moment, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
