

ORDINANCE NO. 7-74 1974

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING TRUCK PARKING AND TRUCK USE
OF ROADWAYS IN SPENCER COMMUNITY PARK, SETTING A
PENALTY THEREFORE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio,
three-fourths of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. The parking of any and all trucks larger than one ton
and/or all truck trailers in the Spencer Community Park or any
other park owned by the Village of Spencer and the use of any
roadway in the Spencer Community Park or any other public park
owned by the Village of Spencer by any truck larger than one
ton, except for deliveries to the park by a truck, is hereby
prohibited.

2. Whoever violates Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be
fined not more than \$50.00.

3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace,
health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio for
the particular reason that truck parking and use of the roadways
by trucks in the Spencer Community Park are presently denying
the public of proper use of the park facilities and is breaking
up the paved surfaces of said park, and that this Ordinance shall
be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
