

ORDINANCE NO. 2-75

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF
BICYCLES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER,
OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village
of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring
herein, as follows:

1. Every person operating a bicycle upon a roadway in the Village of Spencer, Ohio shall ride as near to the right side of the roadway as practicable obeying all traffic rules applicable to vehicles and exercising due care when passing a standing vehicle or one proceeding in the same direction.

2. Persons riding bicycles upon a roadway in the Village of Spencer, Ohio shall ride in single file, except on paths or parts of roadways set aside for the exclusive use of bicycles.

3. Every bicycle when in use at the times specified in Section 4513.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, shall be equipped with a lamp on the front that shall emit a white light visible from a distance of at least five hundred feet (500) to the front and a red reflector on the rear of a type approved by the Ohio Director of Highway Safety that shall be visible from all distances from one hundred (100) to six hundred (600) feet to the rear when directly in front of lawful lower beams of head lights on a motor vehicle and a lamp emitting a red light visible from a distance of five hundred feet to the rear shall be used in addition to the red reflector.

5. Every bicycle shall be equipped with an adequate brake when used on a street or highway within the Village of Spencer, Ohio.

6. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, and for the particular reason that it is immediately necessary to regulate the use of bicycles in Spencer due to the increased use of same in order to continue to insure public safety on the streets, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
