

ORDINANCE NO. 8 -77

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ANNEXATION
TO THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER, OHIO OF CONTIGUOUS
TERRITORY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE, DIRECTING THE
VILLAGE SOLICITOR TO PROSECUTE THE PROCEEDINGS
NECESSARY TO EFFECT IT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Spencer has recently purchased
the Hirschman farm, which is contiguous to the Village, for use
as a Village park; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and proper that said
area be under the Village jurisdiction for police protection and
otherwise; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 709.13 authorizes the annex-
ation of contiguous territory to a municipal corporation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the
Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring
herein, as follows:

1. That annexation of the territory hereinafter described
be and the same is hereby authorized. An accurate description of
said territory is attached hereto as Exhibit A and is made a part
hereof.

2. That the Village Solicitor be and he hereby is
authorized and directed to prosecute the proceedings necessary
to effect such annexation, and shall act as agent for the Village
in the annexation matter.

3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health, safety
and welfare and for the particular reason that is necessary to
have the proposed annexed territory, which will be used for
Village Park purposes and otherwise, under the jurisdiction of

the Village for police protection and other Village services as soon as possible, and that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
