

ORDINANCE NO. 9 -78

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONTRACT
USE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI INTOXILYZER
BY THE SPENCER VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT
FOR A FEE; AUTHORIZING THE CONTRACT USE
OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI JAIL FOR HOLDING
CELLS BY THE SPENCER VILLAGE POLICE DEPART-
MENT FOR A FEE; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of
Spencer, Ohio, three - fourths of its members concurring
herein as follows:

1. That the Spencer Village Police Department
is hereby authorized to use the Intoxilyzer, Serial No.
001283, Model 4011, owned by and located in the Village of
Lodi, Ohio as may be necessary or proper in enforcing the
laws of Ohio and/or the Spencer Village Ordinances and that
the Village Clerk is authorized and directed to pay to the
Village of Lodi the sum of \$300.00 as a one time fee for such
use during its ownership and continued use by the Village
of Lodi.

2. That the Spencer Village Police Department
is hereby authorized to use the facilities of the Village
of Lodi Jail when holding cells are necessary for prisoners
of the Spencer Village Police Department and the Village
Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the
Village of Lodi fees for such service of \$5.00 per day
per prinsoner.

3. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby author-
ized and directed to enter into such written contracts
as approved by Spencer Village Solicitor with the Village
of Lodi for carrying out Sections 1 and 2 of this Ordinance.

4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and for the particular reason that said arrangements with the Village of Lodi are immediately necessary to maintain proper functioning of the Spencer Village Police Department, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
