

ORDINANCE NO. // - 78

AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE BEST BID FOR
RENTAL OF THE AVAILABLE TILLABLE LAND
IN THE SPENCER COMMUNITY PARK AND TO
DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village
of Spencer, Ohio, three - fourths of its members concurring
herein, as follows:

1. Fields numbers 1 and 2 directly south of
the ball diamonds in the Spencer Community Park comprising
a total of approximately 36 acres and Field number 5 located
south of the creek in the Spencer Community Park and comprising
approximately 6.7 acres of land are hereby declared to be
unneded for any municipal purpose and shall be leased for
farming purposes by terms of a lease heretofore approved
by the Council of the Village of Spencer.

2. That the bid of

Floyd & Dorothy Hirschman
is hereby declared to be the most favorable bid for the
Village of Spencer for leasing the available tillable land
in the Spencer Community Park not needed for any municipal
purpose and such bid is hereby accepted. The Mayor and the
Clerk of the Village are hereby authorized and directed to
execute the lease agreement which has been heretofore approved
by Council.

3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the
public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village and
for the particular reason that the lease must be immediately

executed in order for the successful bidder to be able
to prepare the land for spring planting, and that this
Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after
its passage.
