

ORDINANCE NO. 6 -80

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF CLIFF BUILDERS, INC. AS THE LOWEST AND BEST BID FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A PICNIC PAVILION IN FIRESTONE MEMORIAL PARK, WAIVING ANY TECHNICAL INFORMALITY IN THE BID OF CLIFF BUILDERS, INC. AND TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND THE CLERK OF THE VILLAGE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CLIFF BUILDERS, INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SAID PICNIC PAVILION AT THE BID PRICE OF \$36,900.00 AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. That the bid of Cliff Builders, Inc. for the entire cost of constructing the picnic pavilion in Firestone Memorial Park as per the plans and specifications for same on file with the Clerk is hereby declared to be the lowest and best bid and is accepted by the Village of Spencer. All technical informalities concerning said bid are hereby waived by the Village.
2. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Cliff Builders, Inc. on forms submitted by the Village Architect and approved by the Village Solicitor for the bid amount of \$36,900.00 and to pay said amount to Cliff Builders, Inc. in accordance with the payment schedule and conditions stated in said contract and associated documents.
3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer and for the particular reason that it is necessary to immediately enter into a contract with the successful low bidder in order to preserve the favorable bid price and to take advantage of the balance of the current building season, and that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
